Crowthorne Community First Responders are local volunteers, saving local lives. The volunteers all live in Crowthorne. They respond to emergency calls received from the Ambulance Service within Crowthorne, but also Sandhurst, Owlsmoor, Finchampstead and South Wokingham. Because they live locally they have the potential to get to emergency calls before the ambulance service. These extra few minutes are vital – literally saving lives. It also increases the chance of returning to good health after hospital treatment.

Using their own cars, and following training provided by South Central Ambulance Service, they attend life-threatening emergencies. All their equipment is paid for by charitable donations. They are entirely self-funding, responsible for covering their running costs (phone, replacement of medical supplies) as well as equipping and clothing their volunteers.

The Crowthorne Scheme aims to provide cover daily between 8am and 11pm. They expect to respond to over 180 calls in 2011; these range from cardiac arrests and heart attacks, to strokes, allergic reactions, and accidents. Patients range from small children to the elderly, both in local homes, as well as businesses and public places. **Thank you very much for your support**
